VILLAGE OF KEKOSKEE SCHOLARSHIP

BRIEF HISTORY:

The Village of Kekoskee Scholarship is offered by the Village of Kekoskee and the former Town of Williamstown and made available to village/town residents to support their achievements and further their education. The scholarship was established in 2003.

WHO IS EIGIBLE:

To be considered, the applicant must be a graduating Senior and have been a resident of the Village of Kekoskee and/or the Town of Williamstown for two full years (i.e. **residency must have started prior to January of their sophomore year**) during their high school career prior to being eligible to complete the scholarship application. Successful applicants must provide proof of residency to the Village.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Two one thousand dollar (\$ 1000.00) scholarships will be awarded each year (\$1,000 dollars to each selected student).

HOW PAID:

One half of the scholarship (\$500) is paid at the beginning of each semester upon verification of enrollment. To provide verification, the student must provide the following items:

- 1. a class schedule signed by the student's advisor (first and second semester)
- 2. proof of registration signed by the registrar's office (first and second semester)
- 3. an official transcript (second semester)

Mail your verification to the Village of Kekoskee at the address below. Payment will be made after the Village Board reviews your documents.

HOW TO APPLY:

Prepare a packet of materials containing:

- Application form found at kekoskee.com
- HAND WRITTEN Essay that answers the question: What positive opportunities have been presented to you because you're a Village of Kekoskee/Town of Williamstown resident?
- High School Transcript
- Three reference letters detailing how they know you and why they think you should get this scholarship
- Proof of residency: **First Semester Sophomore report card addressed to Parents** or Kekoskee/Williamstown Real Estate Tax Bill/Assessment **from your Sophomore year**.

Selection is made by a committee appointed by the Board of the Village of Kekoskee during a review of packets received from eligible candidates.
